### Corwin Taylor Music Education Leadership Award

**Purpose:** This award is to recognize an individual who has made a significant contribution to the music education of Maryland's youth, whether it be as a teacher, administrator, parent, industry representative, performer, or in another capacity.

The Corwin Taylor Music Education Leadership Award was established in 1993 in memory of Dr. Corwin H. Taylor (1905-1992), noted musician, composer, author, and educator. Dr. Taylor, an active member of the Music Educators National Conference and the Maryland Music Educators Association, was Supervisor of Instrumental Music for the Baltimore Public School system from 1945 to 1968 and a faculty member at the University of Maryland at College Park from 1968 to 1976. He will always be remembered for the great impact he had on the lives and careers of his students and colleagues. The award may be presented annually.
